Mounting With the included screws, mount the bracket at a desired location. Ideal loca-

tions include service doors and high-traffic areas.

Battery Installation Slide battery cover off by pressing your thumb on the battery cover, drop bat-

tery into the exposed chamber, and slide battery cover back into place.

"Learning" into a Panel When the system prompts for a touchpad activation to learn the touchpad,

press BYPASS.

Testing Once learned into a panel, use the touchpad to check system status, bypass

sensors, arm and disarm the system, generate panic alarms, and mute the touchpad. If the system is equipped for light control, also turn individual and

all lights on and off.
