(I had to send my 383 back to Monaco corp as it wasn't multizoned so I flashed it back to the original firmware first and then back to Gufiak's when I got it back)

The final one I had was similar to the one that others have talked about (Woolworths) in that it had USB and media card slots, plus DivX decoding. Dick Smith could not replace it because they now don't offer that model. What a load of stuffing around, I should have bought the 383 right from the start.

I like the option of being able to go back the original firmware too. With the CD/DVD-rw I've flashed I always make a backup of the original first. It has saved me once :-)
